- Most common course sequence


Math I → Math II → Math III → 1 credit Advanced Math

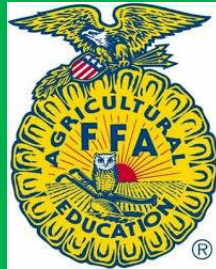
